Community Supported Agriculture programs are an increasingly popular way for consumers to buy local, fresh, seasonal food from growers in their community. Members purchase shares in a local garden and receive a weekly box of ultra-fresh produce - just as one finds at local Farmer's Markets, but without much of the mark-up and expense of those markets.

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) offers its shareholder-members vegetables and other food products produced in an environmentally sustainable manner. Shareholders enjoy garden produce as it matures throughout the growing season.

Because the products are locally grown, the quality and freshness is improved and the cost of the food is fixed. Sustainable methods mean we use no pesticides or herbicides, and use only natural soil amendments like well aged compost from our own poultry litter and manure. This means that while your produce is delicious and the freshest, safest, and most environmentally friendly available; it will not be absolutely flawless. We feel that the flavor, freshness and responsible stewardship of our environment more than compensate for the occasional blemish. Additionally, you may notice some modest variations in the amount of produce if we encounter weather aberrations. Hail, winds, untimely freezes might result in more limited shares. On the other hand, if weather is mild and consistent throughout the season, shares will be abundant!

Shareholders enjoy a variety of vegetables at a very reasonable price. Early in the season, you may expect cool weather vegetables such as lettuce, baby spinach, arugula, radishes, beets, baby carrots, and scallions.

As we move into the middle of the season, you can look forward to the list above augmented by summer squash, zucchini, tomatoes, new potatoes, chard, cucumbers, peas, beans, carrots, onions, shallots, fresh garlic, herbs, and early melons.

Toward the end of the season, expect much of the list above along with onions, okra, pumpkins, peppers, potatoes, melons and winter squash.

We anticipate a 17 week season beginning mid June. Given the variability of production, it's a good idea to look into ways to store and preserve food when it is most plentiful. Weekly deliveries will be made from mid June until mid October .
